

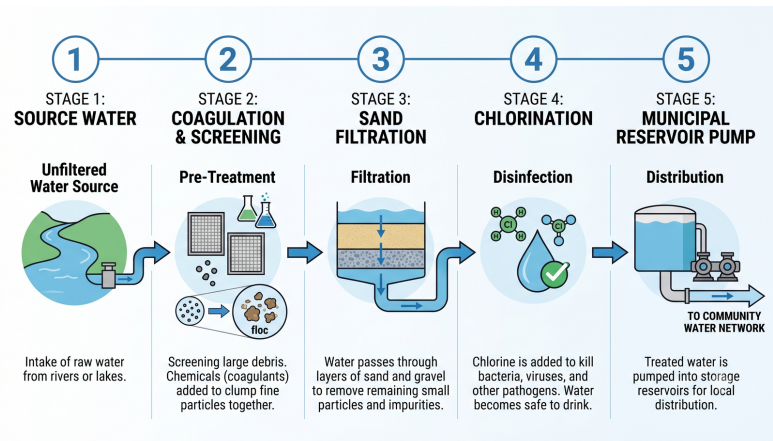

The Journey from Source to Tap: How South Africa's Water is Treated

To meet the strict standards set out by South African National Standards (SANS 241), water utilities and municipalities steer raw water through several complex operational phases:



- **Collection and Intake:** Raw water is extracted from natural sources such as our major rivers (like the Vaal and Orange), provincial dams and reservoirs, or deep underground aquifers, before being channeled to advanced treatment facilities.
- **Screening and Pre-Treatment:** Before chemical treatment begins, heavy debris, branches, and large sediments are mechanically screened out to protect downstream infrastructure.
- **Purification and Filtration:** Through coagulation, flocculation, and sand or carbon filtration systems, finer suspended particles, chemicals, and pollutants are tightly trapped and eliminated, clearing the water to strict potable standards.
- **Disinfection:** To guarantee public health and completely eradicate dangerous pathogens, the water undergoes robust disinfection typically via chlorination or ultraviolet (UV) treatment ensuring it remains sterile as it flows.
- **Storage and Bulk Distribution:** Once certified safe, the treated water is stored in major municipal reservoirs and pumped across thousands of kilometers of pipeline networks directly to your taps, factories, and community centers.
